*About Third Thursdays on Tybee*

The Tybee Island Better Hometown Program hosts musical entertainment in the Main Corridor for residents of and guests to Tybee Island. Third Thursdays on Tybee entertainers rotate each month between the Tybrisa / Strand Roundabout and the lot at Tybee Oaks. The Tybrisa / Strand Roundabout is located in downtown near the Walter W. Parker Pier & Pavilion. The lot at Tybee Oaks is on the northern portion of the Main Corridor at the Shop at Tybee Oaks center. Each location is surrounded by a variety of shops and dining establishments. Third Thursdays on Tybee **Spring Concert Series** takes place every year in the spring (March – May) and fall (September – November). These series have provided **FREE** entertainment for Tybee Island residents and visitors since 2010. Each year performers are selected to play in an outdoor concert setting. The goal of the concerts is to provide artistic excellence and family friendly entertainment through diverse music by local, regional, and national performers.

Set lengths usually run from 60 – 90 minutes, **all beginning at 5:30pm.**

Almost all music genres are allowed, however material must be of a family-friendly nature (i.e., lyrics must be clean). All concerts are sponsored by the City of Tybee Island, individuals and businesses. **To qualify for a performance, please visit our *Information for Performers* document.**
