Dear Area Neighbors,

The movie *Devotion* is returning to Tybee for one day of filming on Wednesday April 7, 2021. Based on the book "Devotion" by Adam Makos, the film tells the inspirational true story of naval fighter pilots in the Korean War. Set in 1950, it features the American war heroes, Ensign Jesse Brown and Lieutenant Tom Hudner.

We will once again be filming on the beach near 3rd St. We are only filming one day but we will be building a set just south of 3rd St for a couple of weeks prior to the actual filming day. After filming it will take about 5 days for our crews to dismantle this set. In order to stage prep and strike trucks, we will be closing 3rd St. to public parking for about 20 days. We will not block any driveways or private entrances on 3rd St.

On the actual filming day-April 7th -the beach area between 2nd and 5th will have limited access. Beach walkers will be asked to walk behind our set or along the shoreline and those wishing to set up "beach camps" may be asked to move further north or south. Pedestrians will be asked to not use the 3rd St. crossover for this day.

Again, we are working closely with the Savannah Regional Film Office (912-447-4159) and the City of Tybee (912-786-4573) and truly appreciate the opportunity to film at Tybee Island. We are aware that we are guests and will keep our noise level and footprint as minimal as possible. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out to us.
