


## Traffic Controls in Effect for April 17, 2021

While no permitted events are scheduled to occur on Tybee Island this weekend, the City expects heavy weekend traffic and will implement traffic controls Saturday, April 17. These controls will prevent gridlock and ensure emergency vehicle have access to the south end. \*Please note that traffic controls are subject to change without notice to respond to real time traffic conditions.



## **BUTLER AVENUE**

- Butler Avenue southbound will taper down to one lane at 15<sup>th</sup> Street, with only the outside right lane open to regular vehicle traffic.
- The inside southbound lane reserved for emergency vehicles only.
- All northbound lanes of Butler Avenue open from Tybrisa Avenue to 1st Street/US 80.
- Butler Avenue open to northbound traffic only between 17<sup>th</sup> Street and Tybrisa

## **TYBRISA STREET**

• Tybrisa eastbound will remain open at Butler Avenue unless traffic backs up

## **INLET AVENUE AND 17<sup>th</sup> STREET**

- 17<sup>th</sup> Street between Inlet Avenue and Butler Avenue one way, flowing eastbound only therefore, only a left turn on to 17<sup>th</sup> Street allowed from Inlet Avenue.
- 17<sup>th</sup> Street closed west of Inlet Avenue.
- Inlet Avenue closed south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street
