The Mayor and City Council are seeking five members for appointment to the Ethics Commission:
three (3) to serve two-year terms and two (2) to serve one-year terms.

The Ethics Commission functions to enhance the public's trust in the integrity of city government and provide an advisory resource to assist with the administration and enforcement of the Code of Ethics.

Member Qualifications

- Upon appointment to the Commission, a person must have resided in the city for at least one year, be registered to vote in city elections, and not hold an elected office.
- For the duration of service on the Commission a member must:
 - Reside in the City of Tybee Island; and
 - Be registered to vote in city elections; and
 - Not hold any other elected office or become a candidate for elected office of the United States, this state, this county, or the city;
 - Not be a city employee;
 - Exhibit strong moral character and good citizenship;
 - Be fit to serve as a public servant.
